First of all we want to say a huge thank you for your continued support during this difficult time. It makes such a difference!

Since our last update in May, things have become more challenging for Milly and her team. The school reopened in July but only a handful of children returned. This means that the school cannot bring back many staff which has a severe knock on effect on salaries. Even though the team, including Milly are now on very little or no income they continue to voluntarily provide food and support for the local community.

One of our main aims has been to fund the educational needs of the children. However, at this time we feel the need for a switch in our focus. Over the next few months we are seeking to support the staff too. Without the dedicated, hard workers, the school cannot run. At this time many are having to sell their homes and are living day by day, hand to mouth.



So until some kind of normality has settled in, whatever that might look like, our bi-monthly donations will go towards helping the staff as well as providing food and educational aids and resources for the children.

Covid-19 has become more prevalent over the past few weeks in Namibia. At this time Rehoboth has not been hit hard but we pray for protection over the area.
