Due to the current Global situation Rehoboth are also in lockdown at this time. Milly took the decision to close the school back in March when the advice from the Namibian Government was the same as here in the UK. The school as you know is so much more than simply a place of education. It's a safe place, a place where support, care and food are provided. Without the school being open many children will go without food.

With this in mind Milly and her team are currently running a soup kitchen 3 times a week for the local community. They have also been putting food parcels together and delivering them to homes in desperate need. We are so encouraged that a local supermarket have got involved and are helping Milly with this venture.

Though times are tough Milly continues to serve and put others above herself. All those volunteering to help Milly are an inspiration to us and we are honoured to support them.
